

Pre-Operative Instructions

- Nothing to eat after midnight the night before surgery. A light early dinner is preferred. Nothing to
 eat or drink after midnight. You may take a sip of water with your morning medications if cleared by
 Surgical Center.
- 2. Wash face and neck the morning of surgery.
- 3. Shampoo hair the morning of surgery.
- 4. Brush teeth and tongue the morning of surgery.
- 5. Men should shave the morning of surgery.
- 6. No make-up or moisturizer the morning of surgery.
- 7. No contact lenses, earrings, hair clips or nail polish the day of surgery.
- 8. No aspirin or aspirin-containing products, herbal remedies, Vitamin E or alcohol (including wine) for two weeks prior to surgery. (Tylenol is okay for mild pain)
- 9. Regular medications should be stopped the morning of surgery unless otherwise instructed.
- 10. Please be accompanied by an adult able to drive you after surgery. Your driver may leave during the surgery and return at a designated time or be available by telephone.
- 11. Wear comfortable loose clothing, preferably nothing that pulls over the head. A hat and sunglasses are appropriate.
- 12. A pillow and blanket may be helpful for your drive home following surgery.
- 13. An adult should stay with you for the first 24 hours after surgery.
- 14. You may begin with the (optional) vitamin/nutritional supplements suggested in the attached handout one week prior to surgery, which are available at most health food stores, pharmacies, or GNC stores. These medications/supplements may improve healing.
